
Bentornato a tutti......

Living to be 100, or 104 like Joe Rollino did


Our guest speaker for Saturday, November 12, will be John Michael Howard, a native of Texas. His father is Michael Howard. His paternal grandmother was Susan Tarantino. John earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in psychology from the University of Dallas in 2016 and a Master of Arts degree in clinical counseling from Marymount University in Arlington, Virginia, in 2021. He currently works as a counselor in Arlington and resides in Northeast Washington, D.C.

He will to speak to us first about Joe Rollino, a strong man and a vegetarian, who lived to be 104. He will then talk to us about the book, "Living to be 100", published by Biomed Books in Concord, California, in 2018, and written by Dr. Michael E. Howard who teaches psychology at Texas State University in San Marcos, Texas.



In regard to the book, he will first define ten terms used in the health science field. He will then make five points about aging. He will follow up by briefly discussing the five zones where there is a very high occurrence of centenarians. Next, he will identify 16 life style characteristics of centenarians. Lastly, he will conclude by informing you how to purchase the book for which he receives no commission.

The total length of his talk will be 20 to 25 minutes, followed by a question and answer period.
