Remembering marble craftsman Francesco Falsinotti

The Italian Heritage Lodge of Fairfax, Order Sons & Daughters of Italy in America mourns the passing of Francesco Falsinotti, 67, past vice-president and beloved husband of current President Dawn Falsinotti. Francesco was born in Pietrasanta. Italy and grew up in the Mediterranean seaside town of Forte dei Marmi. At a young age he developed a lifelong love for soccer, especially his team, Inter Milan.


He served in and was a decorated member of the Italian Army. While growing up in Pietrasanta, world-renowned for marble and sculpture, he began working in the marble trade and quickly became a much sought after marble artisan craftsman. He took his skill throughout Italy, Europe, and the Middle East, eventually settling in the United States. Moving to the Washington D.C. Francesco Falsinotti



area in 1989, he quickly rose to prominence within his industry. He was an extraordinary artisan and a master of his craft. Much of his artistry can be found all over the D.C. metro area. He enjoyed a career at Washington Marble & Granite for 33 years.

A lifelong lover of animals, he doted on his pets. He belonged to several groups including OSDIA as well as soccer and racing clubs. He enjoyed history and developed an in-depth knowledge of the history of World War II. He and his wife toured many of the European WWII sites.

He is survived by his wife of 28 years. Dawn, his children, Sister Agnese of Cornwall, UK, Lara, of Forte dei Marmi and Alex of Fairfax, Va., as well as a sister, Anna Maria Falsinotti and her family.

U.S. Postal Service Issues Stamp for Tomie dePaola



The U.S. Postal Service unveiled a "Forever" postage stamp to honor Tomie dePaola on May 5, 2023, in a first-day-of-issue ceremony inside the Currier Museum of Art in Manchester, New Hampshire. The stamp went on sale nationwide on Saturday, May 6, 2023. A sheet of 20 stamps costs \$12.60. The stamp shows a detail from the cover of *Strega Nona* (Witch Grandmother), a Caldecott Honor Book published in 1975. Tomie dePaola was a prolific children's book author and illustrator whose body of work includes Italian folk tales and legends, informative books, religious and holiday stories, and autobiographical accounts.

Thomas Anthony dePaola was born in Meriden, Connecticut, on September 15, 1934. He was the son of Joseph dePaola and Florence May Downey dePaola. His paternal grandparents had emigrated from the region of Calabria. After earning a Bachelor of Fine Arts from the Pratt Institute in Brooklyn in 1956 and a Master of Fine Arts from the California College of Arts in 1969, he started his writing and illustrating career, working on more than 270 books, and selling more than 25 million copies worldwide. Most were translated into over 20 languages. Over the course of his 50-year career, he won numerous awards, most notably the prestigious Laura Ingalls Wilder Medal in 2011.

On March 23, 2020, he was injured in a fall inside his barn studio, underwent surgery, but died from complications on March 30, 2020, in a hospital in Lebanon, New Hampshire. He was 85. He never married.

SARDINIA

The island of Sardinia is located just west of the boot of Italy. It is the second largest island in the Mediterranean Sea after Sicily. Like Sicily, it is one of the 20 regions of Italy. Our trip was concentrated in the southern half of the island The island has been invaded and controlled by many different groups including Phoenicians, Romans, Vandals, Byzantines, Genoans, Pisans, Arabs, Spaniards, and the House of Savoy. Before all of these, there was an indigenous Prehistoric Nuragic civilization which left many stone structures some of which we saw and are UNESCO protected. All of the groups and civilizations that arrived here have left their mark making the island and it's language much different from the rest. The weather was magnificent, 72-75 degrees and blue skies and sunshine every day. Of course, we enjoyed the local delicious wines, food and gelato. Walking 3-5 miles a day we certainly got our exercise in. A memorable trip enjoyed by all.

Italian Lemon Ricotta Cheesecake

INGREDIENTS:

3 large eggs; room temperature – separate the yolks from the whites and set whites aside ½ cup granulated sugar

1 ½ cup whole milk ricotta (drain if it is watery)

Zest of one lemon

1 teaspoon vanilla extract

2 tablespoons lemon juice

1/3 cup corn starch

3 tablespoons softened butter

Butter a 7" springform pan and line the bottom with parchment paper

Preheat oven to 350°

With a hand mixer, mix the yolks, then add the sugar. Mix in the ricotta cheese. Add the zest, vanilla, lemon juice, corn starch and softened butter. Mix ingredients thoroughly.

Wash the mixers and then whip the egg whites until stiff.

Gently fold the egg whites into the cheese mix with a large spoon. Transfer the mix into the greased springform pan and bake at 350° for 50 minutes.

Let the cake cool down, then cover with plastic wrap and place in refrigerator. This can be done overnight. The cake will firm up the longer it is in the refrigerator. To serve, dust the top with powdered sugar before slicing.
