Límoncello

Ingredients: 10 lemons 1 liter vodka 3 cups white sugar 4 cups water



Zest the lemons, and place zest into a large glass bottle or jar. Pour in vodka. Cover loosely and let infuse for one week at room temperature.

After one week, combine sugar and water in a medium saucepan. Bring to a boil. Do not stir. Boil for 15 minutes. Allow syrup to cool to room temperature.

Stir vodka mixture into syrup. Strain into glass bottles, and seal each bottle with a cork. Let mixture age for 2 weeks at room temperature.

Place bottled liqueur into the freezer. When icy cold, serve in chilled vodka glasses or shot glasses.

Another Italian-themed stamp to be issued by the U.S. Postal Service by

Joseph (Sonny) Scafetta Jr.

The U.S. Postal Service will issue another Italian-themed stamp on Thursday, August 12, when it will release a stamp recognizing bocce as one of eight popular back yard games. Bocce, also spelled boccie and bocci, originated in Italy and is played with differently colored wooden bowling balls and a small white ball, known as the pallino, on a long, narrow, flat, clay or dirt court. The other seven games being recognized are badminton, corn hole also known as bean bag toss, croquet, frisbee throwing, horse shoe tossing, tether ball, and baseball.

The first day of issue ceremony will take place during the Great American Stamp Show to be held in Hall G of the Donald E. Stephens Convention Center in Rosemont outside Chicago, Illinois. A pane of 16 forever stamps, showing two of each game, may be purchased nationwide at all local post offices starting on Friday, August 13. The price for a single pane will be \$8.80. On Sunday, August 29, the price will increase to \$9.28 when the first-class mailing rate will go up to 58 cents. The pane will be available until August 11, 2022, when it will go off sale.

Meet The Scafetta Family -Sonny, Terí & Joey Scafetta

Joseph "Sonny" Scafetta Jr. was born in the city of Chester, Penna., in 1947. His father Giuseppe had emigrated as a teenager from the city of Vasto on the Adriatic coast in the province of Chieti in the region of Abruzzo in early 1915 to Washington, D.C., before Italy entered World War I. The family moved to the borough of Pottstown, Penna., when Sonny was 12 and he graduated from the Pottstown Senior High School in 1965. He earned a Bachelor of Science degree in aerospace engineering from the Pennsylvania State University in 1969, a Juris Doctor degree from the University of Pittsburgh in 1972, and a Masters in Patent Law degree from Georgetown University in 1973. From October 1973 to December 1974, he served as a law clerk for a federal trial judge in Columbia, South Carolina. Beginning in January 1975 to date, he has been employed as an associate at various law firms in the District of Columbia, Arlington and Alexandria. To enhance his management skills, he earned a Masters of Business Administration degree with honors from the George Washington University in 1983. He has also had 15 articles published in various legal journals over the years. Two of them have won awards. He is currently employed part time as senior counsel for the intellectual property law firm of Ditthavong, Steiner & Mlotkowski in Old Town. Sonny is fluent in Italian. He has also studied Spanish and French.

In 1979 Sonny joined the Avanti Italiani Lodge, a lodge for singles, and served as its president from 1981 until 1983 when he was elected as the orator on the Grand Council of Virginia. He married another member, Teresa Talierco, on July 4, 1986, and they honeymooned in Italy where they visited relatives in Rome, Vasto and Ischia. They then transferred to the George Washington Lodge. Sonny was elected state president in 1993 and served one two-year term. He continued on the Grand Council in different positions until 2007 for a total of 24 consecutive years which is still a state record. The main focus of his tenure on the Grand Council was the Commission for Social Justice. Sonny, Teri and their son Joey are now members of our lodge.

Teresa "Teri" Margaret Talierco was born in the borough of Coatesville, Penna., in 1951. Her paternal grandfather Giovanni had emigrated from the island of Ischia in the Gulf of Naples and her paternal grandmother, Olivia Nerone, had emigrated from the city of Naples. Teri graduated from Coatesville Senior High School in 1969. She earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in psychology and sociology from Trinity College (now University) in Washington, D.C. in 1973 and a Master of Arts degree in clinical psychology from Loyola University in Baltimore, Md., in 1975. She then went to work as a family counselor for Dominion Psychiatric Hospital in Falls Church. In 1982, she joined the Avanti Italiani Lodge and studied Italian for two years. She served as its president from 1984 until 1986 when she married Sonny Scafetta on July 4 of that year. They then transferred from that singles lodge to the George Washington Lodge where she served as president from 1993 to 1995. They eventually transferred to our lodge. She continued to work for the psychiatric hospital until 1998 when their only child was born. After the birth, she opened a solo private family counseling practice which she continues to operate full time in McLean.

Joseph "Joey" Anthony Scafetta III was born in Washington, D.C., in 1998. When he was 4, he traveled to Italy with his parents to visit relatives. He joined our lodge in 2016 when he turned 18. He studied Italian for two years and was a member of the National Honor Society. He graduated *cum laude* from Bishop Ireton Catholic High School in Alexandria in May 2017. He was awarded the Joseph Fulton Memorial Scholarship from the Grand Lodge of Virginia at the state convention in June 2017. He is currently enrolled at Marymount University in Arlington. He is studying mathematics and information technology. Since he is pursuing a dual degree, he is entering his "super" senior year in the Fall of 2021. He expects to graduate in May 2022.

BOSA (SARDINIA)

Bosa is a town and comune in the province of Oristano, part of the Sardinia region of Italy. It is located about two-thirds of the way up the west coast of Sardinia, on a small hill, about 3 kilometers inland on the north bank of the Temo River. Bosa is a mix of traditional and modern, it has a unique and compelling historic center. There is a warren of cobbled streets with pastel colored medieval tower houses called Sa Costa. The main street in the old town, Corso Vittorio Emanuele, is lined by 19thcentury palazzos with wrought iron balconies, and interesting shops, cafes and bars. Castello Malaspina, dating from 1112, guards Bosa at the top of the hill. The River Temo runs through Bosa and is lined with palm trees on one bank and derelict tanneries on the other, which are of historic and national significance. Bosa is a member of 'I Borghi più Belli d'Italia' (The most beautiful villages in Italy) an association of small Italian towns.


