Sophia Loren - A No-Nonsense Icon

As a child growing up in the 40s and 50s, I remember when our fathers returned from WWII and bought our Grandma the family's first Crossly TV. After every spaghetti and meatball Sunday meal, all 21 of us (first cousins on my mother's side) squeezed into Grandma's living room to watch Ed Sullivan. All of the women in my family were beauticians, and most of the men were barbers, all fashion conscious, trying to fit into American culture, trying not to look "Italian," which to them meant "poor," because they had all grown-up poor. The only Italian spoken was on Sundays, with Grandma. Our parents had been punished in school if they spoke Italian, so gradually, they all lost their mother tongue, focusing on mastering English, on being American. I didn't want to be Italian. Like my parents, I just wanted to fit in, and look and talk like everyone else in the WASP suburban neighborhood into which we had escaped. But Grandma stayed behind. So, to Grandma's house we went, every Sunday of my life.

Grandma didn't dye her hair, try to look younger, wear make-up or follow fashion. She was just "Grandma," the robust, kindly, soft-spoken matriarch of the family, cooking and loving us all. But her daughters, the beauticians, were in a profession dedicated to beauty. Absolutely gorgeous, with hourglass figures, they found in Sophia Loren what was missing in their Italian immigrant neighborhoods...Respect for Italian women. Once Sophia Loren hit the silver screen, none of the daughters missed her films. She set the standard for them and for their customers! Her photos hung in their beauty shops. When Sophia Loren had a different hairdo in a movie, they copied her, offering Sophia Loren hairdos to their customers. The Ed Sullivan show may have brought us all together on Sunday evenings, but it was Sophia Loren, the beyond-beautiful Italian woman, who gave us pride.

And so it was with both joy and sadness that last November I attended a live interview of Sophia Loren at Montgomery College in Maryland. All I could think of was how sad it was that my mom and her sisters were gone, and that I was about to live their dream...to see her in person! Ten feet away! Just a month before, I watched a television interview between she and her son, Edoardo Ponti, and TIVOed it, watching it over and over. Not surprisingly, she was still beyond beautiful, but oh, so self-assured and direct! She did not flinch when asked about her poor beginnings or about Cary Grant who, as Edoardo put it, "Almost cost me my birth." What I found most moving was that she was so humble, constantly giving credit to others, like her director, Vittorio DeSica, her husband, and leading men, such as Peter O'Toole, who helped her perfect her art.

And so it was not at all a shock to me when, during the audience participation, question-and-answer portion of the interview, she flatly just refused to answer certain, inappropriate personal questions. That's it. Just didn't answer. Or, she bluntly said, "Listen, I am a grandmother, and it is I who determine my legacy for my family," or something to that effect. I wanted to jump up and cheer, "GOOD FOR YOU!" Before my very eyes was an 86 year-old Italian woman still showing us to be strong, find our voice, and when it counts, use it!

Recently, I learned that at the age of 85 (last year), after ten years of not being in a film, that "The Life Ahead" ("La Vita davanti a se"), directed by none other than her son, Edoardo, is about to be released. NetFlix purchased the world-wide rights. In it, she plays a Holocaust survivor. This "no apologies" lady, our icon, is still not just a pretty face, but herself a survivor. Sophia Villani Scicolone (her real name) honors every single woman by her example of gratefulness, courage, dignity, and most of all, honesty. THESE virtues are epitomized in all societies for all people, but oh, how very lucky we Italian women are that she was and IS still there for us.


