The film follows Marcello Rubini (Marcello Mastroianni), a journalist writing for gossip magazines, over seven days and nights on his journey through Rome in a fruitless search for love and happiness. It is a cautionary tale of a man without a center. The film is structured as a series of nights and dawns, of descents and ascents. La Dolce Vita won the Palme d'Or (Golden Palm) at the 1960 Cannes Film Festival and the Oscar for Best Costumes. This is one of the most critically acclaimed films of all time. The price is \$10.00.
