Carissimi amici,

Just recently the April 2017 issue of *Voce Italiana* was given to me for my reading pleasure, which was most certainly true, but it also sparked some fun and interesting conversations with my 89 year-old momma who is visiting with me from New Jersey. In two articles about Holy Rosary's annual Fr. DeCarlo Breakfast and a 1971 Tony Bennett concert to benefit Villa Rosa, momma recalled many of the familiar names mentioned and her memories of Holy Rosary's first pastor, Fr. De Carlo, who baptized me, married her and my dad, her parents and various other relatives at Holy Rosary Church. Not to mention the picture of the demolition of the rectory as well as various mentions about "The Lido Club" to which her father was a member in its beginning years, and her brother and my dad were officers and members for many years. (I remember those days very vividly when my older brother and I were allowed to attend Lido Club formal events.) I love to hear her stories about her immigrant father and Italian-American mother who dedicated themselves to help furnish Villa Rosa back in the day by sewing curtains for the windows, purchasing items to furnish the retirement home and helping the home get up and running. How lovely to have these memories passed on, especially when these institutions are still vibrant and local to us.
